ORDINANCE NO. 764

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SHELTON, BUFFALO COUNTY, NEBRASKA AMENDING SECTION 7-302 AND SECTION 7-305 RELATING TO FIREWORKS: PERMITTED FIREWORKS AND HOURS: TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHELTON, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Section 7-302 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Shelton, Nebraska is amended to read as follows:

7-302 FIREWORKS: PERMITTED FIREWORKS: It shall be unlawful for any person to ignite or cause to be exploded fireworks or firecrackers of any description whatsoever, except those allowed by Nebraska State Laws.

The provision of this section shall not apply to any fireworks to be used for purposes of public exhibition or display under authorization of the Governing Body or to fireworks furnished for agricultural purpose pursuant to written authorization from the State Fire Marshal (*ref.17-566, 28-1241, 28-1244, 28-1245 RS Neb*)

SECTION 2. Section 7-305 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Shelton, Nebraska is amended to read as follows:

7-305 DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS: HOURS. Permissible fireworks may be discharged, exploded or used within the Village limits of Shelton on June 24th through July 4th of each year; provided that on such day the discharge and explosion of fireworks shall be permitted only during the following times:

June 24th through July 3rd Sun thru Thurs- 8:00 am to 11:00 pm
June 24th through July 3rd Fri & Sat- 8:00 am to 12:00 midnight
July 4th - 8:00 am to 1:00 am the 5th of July

The discharge or exploding of fireworks with the Village of Shelton on any dates or other times other than as set forth in this ordinance and section shall be unlawful.

SECTION 3. Any and all other ordinances or section thereof passed and approved prior to the passage, approval and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting as required by law.
